The load is projected out from the equipment's front so it is visible to the forklift operator. This type of forklift truck should just be utilized on prepared surface or on stable, level ground.

The trainee would learn to properly raise and lower the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both forwards and backwards. ### Walkie Pallet Trucks
