Prince George Bucket Truck Training - The Vehicle-Mounted Aerial Work Platform or likewise called bucket truck training program is intended to lessen the chance of personal injury and incident while working in close proximity or with bucket trucks by effectively training qualified operators. An aerial lift device is whatever vehicle-mounted device, articulating or telescoping, or both, which is utilized to position personnel to reach locations that will otherwise be not accessible. Aerial lift devices are used in order to elevate personnel to above-ground work sites.

The goal of the program is to provide operators with the knowledge, skills, abilities, and training materials needed to be able to learn to operate vehicle-mounted aerial work platforms safely and effectively.

The program includes a hands-on training session and a classroom training session. To become certified, participants should be successful in both components. A full-size certificate and a wallet-size certificate will be issued upon completing the program.

Types of lifts include articulating boom platforms, extensible boom platforms, aerial ladders and aerial ladder trucks, vertical towers and any combination of these devices. Aerial lift devices are often made of metal, wood, fiberglass, reinforced plastic or other materials.

Definitions

Articulating boom platform: has two or more hinged boom parts.

Extensible boom platform: has either a telescopic boom or an extensible boom.

Platform: part of the aerial device which is designed to carry personnel.

Mobile unit: any aerial device together with its components like for instance vehicle and related machinery.

Employers have the responsibility to ensure their employee receive correct training before operating aerial devices. Workers must make certain they also obtain the needed training and that they do not operate lift devices if they are not authorized to do so. Employees should make certain that they wear the proper protective equipment while working from the platform.

The course content used in the bucket truck training program comprises operating the vehicle-mounted aerial work platform, preshift inspections, safe operating practices, lifting capacity, use of emergency controls, and administering theory and practical tests. Operators would know legal requirements under the local and federal regulations.
